



## QlikView Remix Policy

### 1. Procedure

- Provided that licensee is current on maintenance and support for its entire QlikView license estate, all standalone QlikView Client Access Licenses and local clients purchased by licensee (and which are subject to a Qlik license agreement) may be remixed at the licensee's option into Qlik Sense Tokens in accordance with the Remix Ratios set forth in Section 2 of this Policy
- Each Remix transaction requires execution of a remix certificate with Qlik. Once elected, remix must be completed in accordance with the terms of the certificate
- For licensees holding less than 100 Named User CALs or equivalent prior to any remix transaction, all such QlikView CALs must be remixed in one remix transaction
- For licensees holding 100 or more Named User CALs or equivalent may remix a minimum of 100 Named User CALs or equivalent in one initial remix transaction. Any subsequent remix of QlikView CALs requires the remix of all remaining QlikView CALs to Qlik Sense Tokens.
- Then-current Maintenance Fees remain payable for all licenses held by licensee following remix
- Once remixed, the Qlik Sense Tokens cannot be remixed back to QlikView CALs
- A licensee is not entitled to a refund of license or maintenance fees in the event the value of the Qlik Sense Tokens is less than the value of the total fees paid for the QlikView CALs

### 2. Remix Ratios

The remix ratios for QlikView CALs into Qlik Sense Tokens and QlikView Test Servers into Qlik Sense Test Sites are set forth below. The conversion and remix rights set forth in this Policy apply only to the QlikView CALs and QlikView Test Servers listed below. Future software products and/or other currently available software products are specifically excluded. The following are specifically excluded from the Remix Policy: future software products, currently available software products other than QlikView, core-based licenses and any licensees granted to an end user as part of an OEM or SaaS offering.
